

Friends of the Solana Beach Library 2022 Educational Scholarships

Deadline: May 31, 2022 Award Amount: **\$1,000 each**

Purpose of the Scholarships:

To provide financial assistance in the form of **four \$1,000 educational scholarships** to graduating high-school seniors or continuing or returning students who live within the city limits of Solana Beach, for continuing education at a community college, a four-year college or university, a graduate/professional school, or a technical/vocational/career school, in the United States. Scholarships will be awarded to four students. Each scholarship is a one-time award.

Scholarship Committee:

The Board of Directors of the Friends of the Solana Beach Library has assembled a Scholarship Committee to review written applications and references and select the four scholarship recipients for approval by the Board.

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible, an applicant must live within the boundaries of the city of Solana Beach, have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 (to be verified by the school) for the most recent three years for which a GPA is available, and demonstrate financial need. The applicant cannot be a family member or a member of the household of a Director of the Friends of the Solana Beach library.

Application Process:

The application for the 2022 Friends of the Solana Beach Library Scholarship can be downloaded as a PDF from the Friends website www.friendsofsolanabeachlibrary.org/scholarships and printed by the applicant. Printed applications forms are also available at the Solana Beach Library. If downloading from the website or picking up a form at the library is not an option for you, please email FOSBL2022@aol.com for help, or phone 858-775-3629 or 858-344-4356.

All applicants must complete and submit the **application form** by **May 31, 2022,** along with an **essay**, a completed **permission form**, and **two letters of recommendation** (at least one letter should be from a teacher and the other from an adult who is not related to the student and who can provide information about the student to the Scholarship Committee). **For procedures for submitting the application and associated materials,** see the bottom of page 4.

For each application received, the Scholarship Committee will email a **notification of receipt** to the applicant. Applicants should receive notification within a week of submission. If not, they should first check their Spam folder, and if they don't find it there, **contact the Scholarship Committee**: **FOSBL2020@aol.com**

Selection Criteria:

The Scholarship Committee will consider financial need, GPA, community activities, extracurricular activities, awards and recognition, and the two letters of recommendation.

Award Notification:

A member of the Scholarship Committee will contact each scholarship recipient via a letter from the Friends of the Solana Beach Library in June, 2022.

Procedures for Receiving the Award:

Each scholarship recipient must verify acceptance to a community college, college or university, graduate/professional school, or vocational/technical/career school in the United States before the scholarship check will be released.
